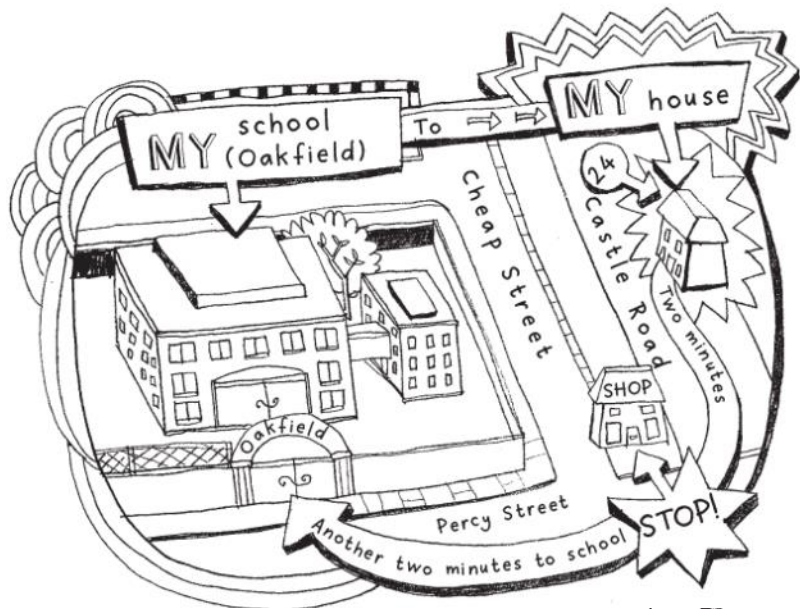


Even though I only live four minutes away from my school, I'm often late.
