


Wrens

Understanding of the world

We will continue to discuss and explore life cycles of living things. We will observe at changes over time and find out about animals that hatch from eggs.

Construction and Expressive Art & Design

We will use a variety of materials to create our fossils and pet dinosaur.
We will use the instruments to create our own dinosaur sounds.

Maths

We will be exploring maths in our environment looking for patterns, 2d and 3d shapes. We will create potions measuring capacity of containers.

Literacy
