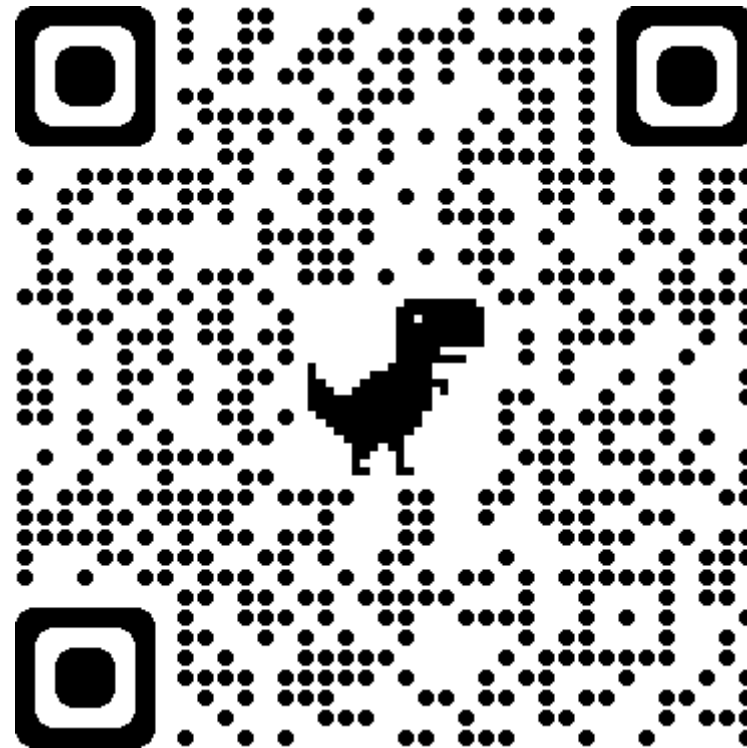
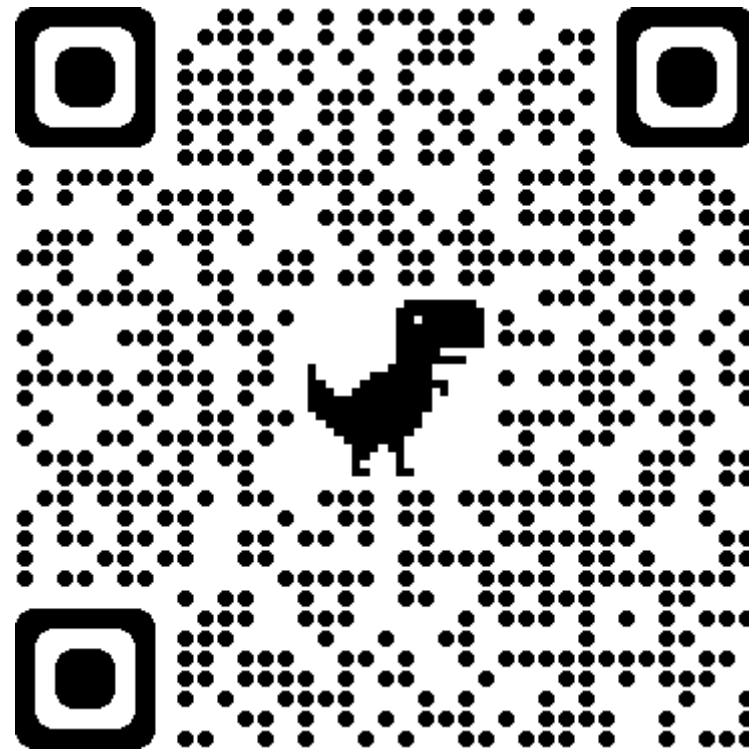


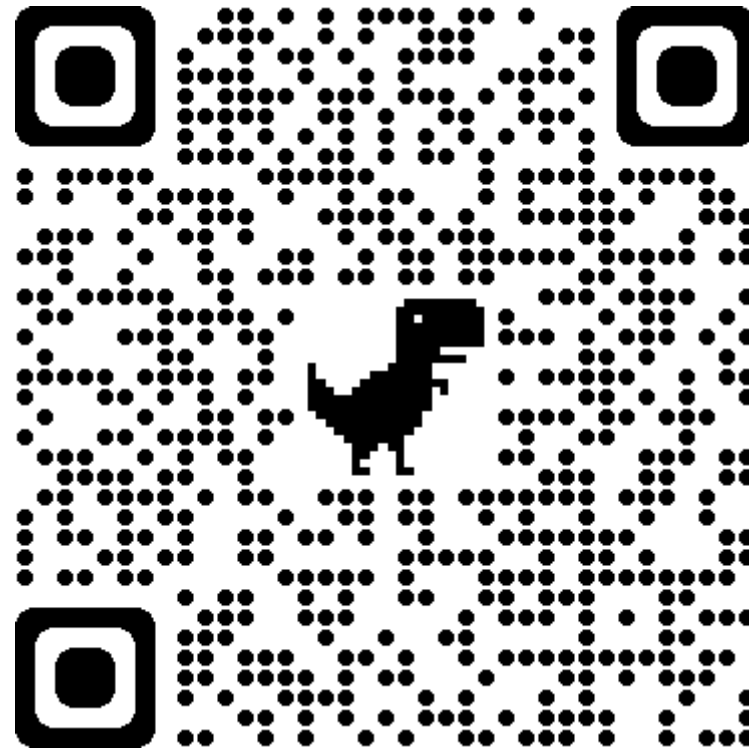
Sketch the outline of the ship. Include the funnels.



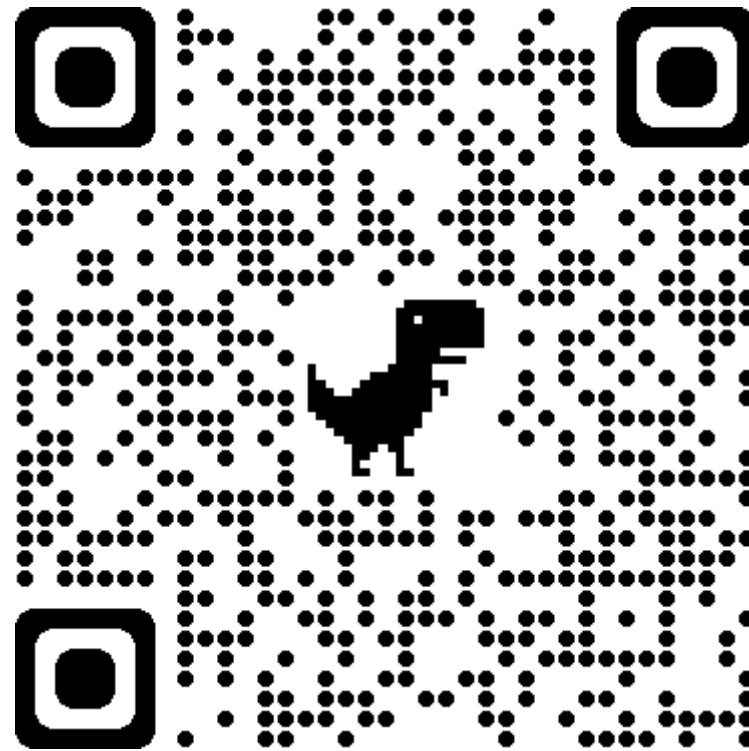
Add details to the outline of your ship, and label them. Try not to draw inside of your outline.



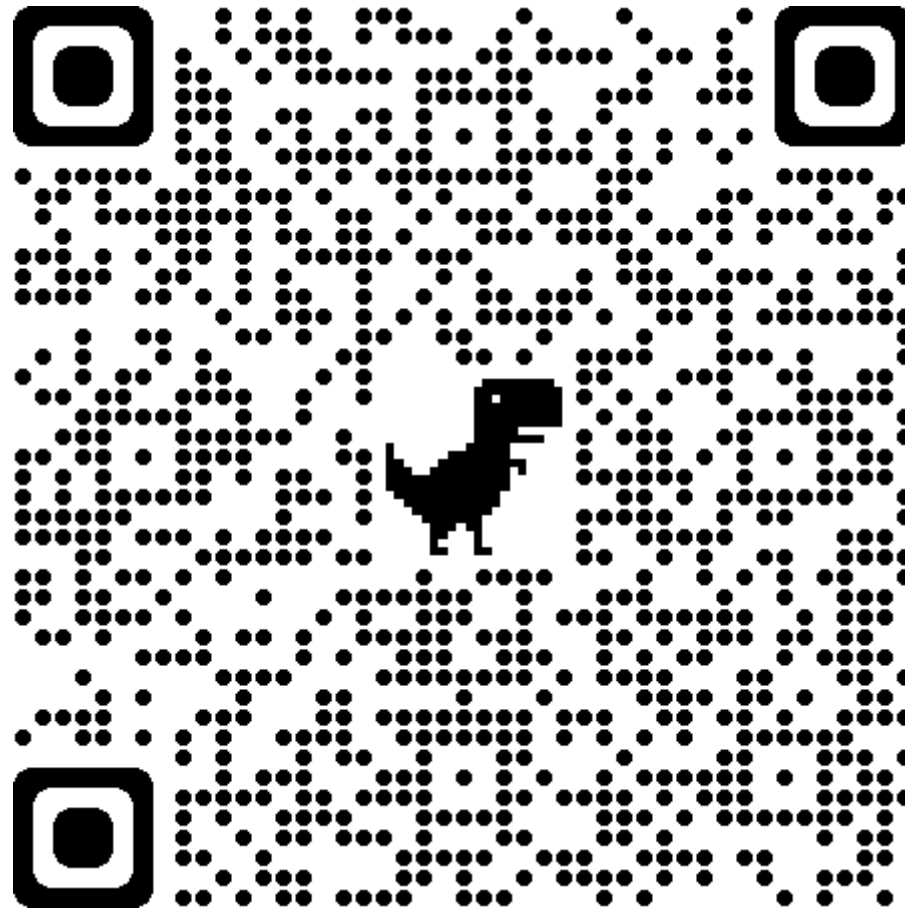
Find out how many decks the Titanic had,
and draw them in.



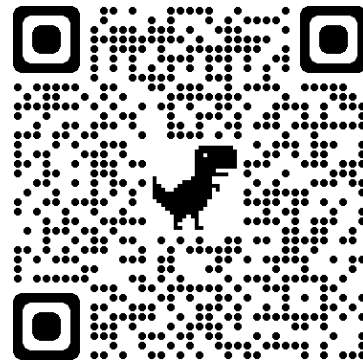
Now find out what would have been on each of the decks, and annotate them to show what was there.
