Welcome back I hope you had a good break. This half-term's topic is 'Treasure Seekers'. We will be finding treasure exploring the pirate theme and travelling the 7 seas.



We aim to teach as much of our curriculum through our topic and in addition will be covering the following:

- In Maths we will be following the New National Curriculum, and where appropriate will link this with our topic. We will be looking at problem solving, place value and consolidating what we have learnt this year.
- In Literacy we will continue to have daily phonic sessions including handwriting and spelling. We will be looking at writing stories and poems in a fantasy setting related to the topic.
- In science we will we will be learning about the seasons and animals.
- In geography we will we will be learning about maps and creating our own maps.
- In ICT skills we will be learning how to input instructions into the ipad, computers and cameras.
- In Music we will explore timbre, tempo and dynamics and how music can tell a story.
- In Art the children will be learning to recreate stormy sea pictures.
- In PE we will be covering games and developing swimming confidence and skills.
