

Attendance Policy for Childhood Illnesses

Illness	Recommended time of school
Diarrhoea and/or vomiting	48 hours from last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting
Hand foot and mouth	Return when lesions have crusted over
Conjunctivitis	None
Measles	Return to school 4 days after rash appears
Chickenpox	Until lesions are crusted over and child feels well
German Measles	5 days after rash has started
Mumps	5 days after start of swollen glands
Whooping Cough	5 days after starting antibiotics
Head Lice	None

Treatment and Comments
Please ensure the school is informed of the condition
Wash Hands regularly
Please inform the school of this so we can keep a record of any cases
It is important that all spots have crusted over to avoid spreading to others
Inform school so any pregnant staff can told
Please inform the school of this so we can keep a record of any cases
Non infectious cough may last for weeks
Treatment required where live head lice have been seen
